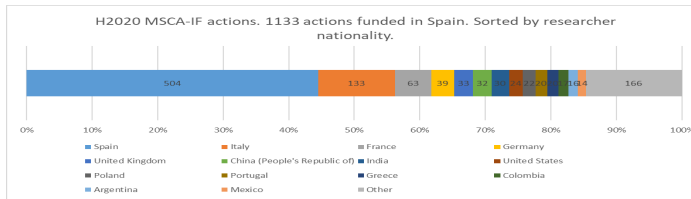

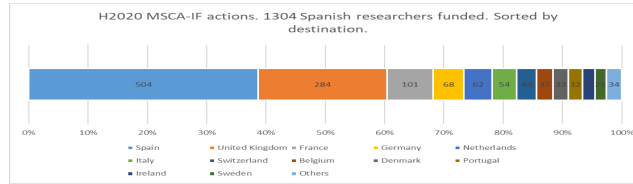

H2020 MSCA-IF: Facts and figures on Spanish participation (1)



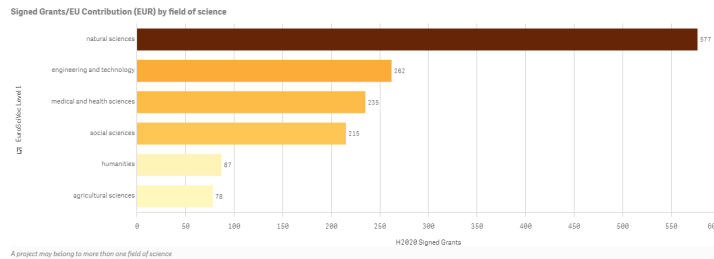
Who comes to ES?

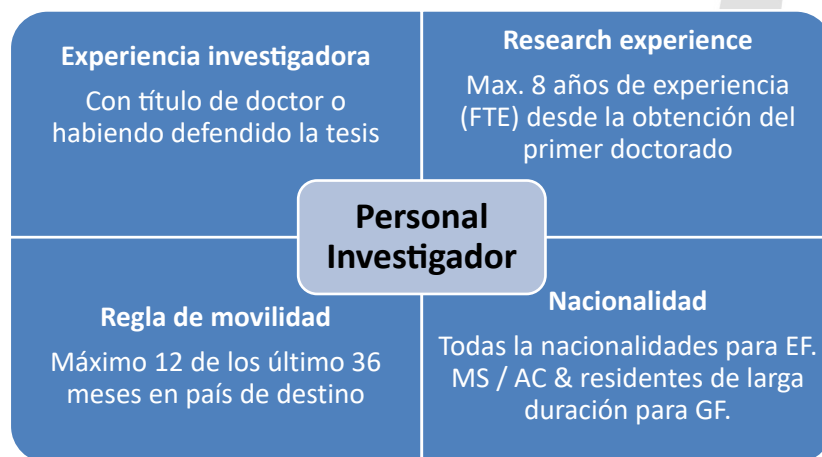
